## CURED 47 OF CHOLERA.

Prof. Stumpf Used New Remedy Successfully in Balkan Campaign. Special Cable to THE NEW YORK TIMES.

BERLIN. Dec. 14.—Prof. Julius Stumpf of the University of Wuerzburg has discovered a new cure for cholera, consisting of a mixture of clay and other substances extracted from earth which kills the cholera bacilli in the intestines.

Prof. Stumpf used the remedy in the Balkan campaign. Of thirty-one cholera patients treated, only one, who was hopelessly infected, died. Of twenty women treated in Belgrade seventeen were saved.
