

# **CURED 47 OF CHOLERA.**

**Prof. Stumpf Used New Remedy  
Successfully in Balkan Campaign.**

**BERLIN, Dec. 14.—Prof. Julius Stumpf of the University of Wuerzburg has discovered a new cure for cholera, consisting of a mixture of clay and other substances extracted from earth which kills the cholera bacilli in the intestines.**

**Prof. Stumpf used the remedy in the Balkan campaign. Of thirty-one cholera patients treated, only one, who was hopelessly infected, died. Of twenty women treated in Belgrade seventeen were saved.**
